FULL ACA DIPLOMA

To receive a diploma from ACA and school transcripts mailed to colleges, students must complete the requirements listed below during their four years of high school.

In addition, ACA graduates must meet the following requirements:

Four chronological years of high school

Two book seminars per year enrolled at ACA (See 2008-2009 Handbook) **NEW**

Completion of PEERS testing, Senior Thesis Presentation, College Guidance Counseling

Minimum of 14 units from the requirements above completed at ACA

Be a student in good standing

Completion of all paper work and submission of the \$100 graduation fee.

HOME SCHOOL GRADUATION PRIVILEGE

Home school students may participate in all areas of the graduation ceremony with ACA students who are receiving a full diploma including wearing the school cap and gown, receiving the individualized recognition and participating in the reception. The only difference lies in the home-schooled student receiving a home school diploma presented by his or her parents on the platform instead of an ACA diploma. The requirements for participation are as follows:

Completion of all high school credits as outlined by the parents. (Parents must submit requirements and a transcript showing how students met those requirements.)

Completion of a minimum of 6 units of credit total at ACA during high school years. **NEW**

Attendance (full or part time) at ACA for a minimum of two years. **NEW** (Exception for foreign students or special circumstances as approved by the administration of ACA)

Two book seminars per year enrolled at ACA (See 2008-2009 Handbook) **NEW**

Participation in extra curricular events including house activities. (Become a part of the life of the school)

Be a student in good standing.

Completion of all paper work and submission of the \$100 graduation fee
