Fees & Payment: \$250 for both weeks if paid for (or deposit made) on or before May 31st. Price increases to \$275 beginning June 1. There is a 10% discount for a second child in the same family. Your camp fee also includes: *1 USB digital copy of cast photos (over 150 photos), *1 USB digital archived copy of our show filmed by a member of ACA's Film making class, a copy of the listening vocal recording, a cast tee shirt, a cast libretto (cast member keeps), costuming for the show, and 2 complimentary tickets to the show of your choice (additional tickets may be purchased at \$5 per ticket). Payment in full or a non-refundable deposit of \$75 (one camper) or \$100 (two campers) needs to be made in the school office or on our website (www.acatulsa.org - look for the link to Summer Weeks of the Arts) using Paypal with the balance due before the first day of camp. *Allow 2 weeks for photos and 4-6 weeks for video.
Your child will not be enrolled unless a DEPOSIT or PAYMENT IN FULL accompanies this Registration Form. All deposits are non-refundable.

## GENERAL INFORMATION: "BYE BYE BIRDIE"

**REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS SHOW**: Grades 4-12 (Either entering or exiting that grade). NOTE: You do NOT need to attend Augustine Christian Academy to participate in this show but you do need to meet the grade and show requirements. Students need to be able to participate in a full day of activities that include singing, choreography, acting, listening, taking direction, and participate with a positive attitude.

#### FREE AUDITION / CAST PLACEMENT WORKSHOP FOR "BYE BYE BIRDIE"

Saturday, May 22, 9am – Noon. Join us in the Performing Arts Building (last building in our parking lot - next to the Sherman Williams paint store). This workshop is for cast placement. If you can't make the workshop, you will be given a part based on your age/experience listed on your Registration Form. ALL students that audition and/or have returned their Registration Form w/payment, will be cast. Scripts and Listening CD's will be distributed upon paid Registration Forms at the workshop and/or when Registration Forms are returned to the school office.

*Saturday, May 22nd, Noon - 1pm* - Required "Meet & Greet" for Cast Parents. (Cast will have some snacks and participate in some theatre games during this time). Cast deposits/fees may be made at this time as well. Campers attending the workshop need to pay their deposit or their complete fee in order to be cast in the first cast list that goes out May 25<sup>th</sup>.

May 25th – "Bye Bye Birdie" Cast List will be sent out via EMAIL We will add new cast members as registrations come in. A maximum of 50 cast members will be accepted for this show.

**June 1** - Camp fee increases to \$275 per camper. Deposits still accepted. Campers will be added to the cast list once their paid Registration has been received.

*Camp Weeks:* There are TWO sessions (weeks) to this year's musical theatre camp. They are NOT separate camps and <u>attendance in both weeks are required for this show</u>. (\*Talk with director if you have questions or need clarification.)

- ❖ June 7th 11th (12:30 4:00 pm) First week of camp. ALL character lines and music memorized by first day of camp. This first week we will work on music, acting and developing character rolls, costuming, hair and make-up, props and stage craft, understanding how set design, costuming, music, and character all work together to create the musical theatre experience.
- ❖ June 14th 18th (9am 4pm) The cast will focus on choreography for musical numbers, blocking the scenes, and running the show. Dress rehearsal is Friday, June 18th.
- \* REQUIRED PERFORMANCES: Friday, June 18th (7pm) and Saturday, June 19th (11am).

MORNING DROP OFF is no earlier than 15 minutes prior to camp and afternoon PICK-UP is no later than 15 minutes after end of camp.

It is very important that students arrive on time for morning warm-ups so that they will be properly conditioned for the day's activities. It is also important that students remain through the last rehearsal period of the day. This is when we are working on Choreography, blocking, character development, solos, duets, and group numbers. We need this opportunity to rehearse production numbers with the entire cast or small groups.

\*Note: campers being picked up later than 15 minutes after camp could be fined a fee of \$5 per every 15 minutes late unless prior arrangements have been made. Traffic problems or unforeseeable mishaps occur. IF you are going to be delayed in picking up your camper, please call the school office or text the Director so that she can make arrangements to stay and can let the camper know as well.

#### WHAT SHOULD THE CAMPER BRING TO CAMP

- A sack lunch, drink, plastic or metal water bottle, and one or two snacks
- Do not bring microwaveable meals.
- Please avoid foods containing any types of nuts.
- Script (put in a pocket notebook or binder) and at least two pencils, and a highlighter.

#### DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Dress in comfortable T-shirts and shorts, yoga pants or capris (girls). *Please dress conservatively* (no short shorts, inappropriate tee shirts, tight fitting tee shirts, or muscle shirts.) Shoes should be fully enclosed, either jazz, ballet, character shoes or sneakers secured with laces or velcro. *NO flip-flops, sandals, crocs or shoes that have slippery soles or will come off feet easily.* 

#### MAKE-UP – due on or before WEDNESDAY, JUNE 16th

Students will need the following make-up items. You can purchase these items from Dollar Tree or Walmart. You do not need to spend a ton of money on them. We do not share make-up items. Campers will be shown how to apply their own make-up. *Please put items in either a designated make-up bag or a gallon zip bag with camper's name clearly marked on the outside of the bag.* 

- Foundation liquid or powder in a natural shade. (girls and guys)
- Blush (light pink) guys and girls
- Mascara (black) (girls)
- Lipstick (grades 4-5 girls pink; 6th -high school girls red)
- Eye Pencil (brown or black) 6th grade High School girls and guys
- Hair gel (all guys in cast show set in the 60's), hair spray (all girls in cast)
- 1 pkg of rubber bands or coated bands all girls with shoulder length hair and longer
- Hair pins or bobby pins (1 pkg) girls (we use these not only hair, but to keep hats on or large bows in place.)
- Hair brush or comb

#### **Personal Costume Attire:**

Students will need to supply their own tights (girls - if needed), socks (girls and guys), and shoes for the show. Shoes for the show will consist of black Jazz, ballet, character, or dress shoes, or athletic shoes depending on the character. The Director will make those decisions and discuss individually with cast members once the show is cast.

Performances for "Bye Bye Birdie" will take place in the Great Room of AUGUSTINE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY.

**Tickets:** Our two performances are Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 7pm and Saturday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at 11am. Cast parents may pick up their 2 complimentary tickets plus any additional tickets they wish to purchase for \$5 each from the school office beginning **Monday**, **June 14 – Wednesday**, **June 16th.** On June 17<sup>th</sup> tickets will go on sale to the general public. *ALL TICKETS ARE RESERVED SEATING*. Tickets can **NOT** be refunded but may be exchanged for another show date based on availability.

The ACA Concessions Stand will be open during both performances.

**CANDY-GRAMS** \$1 - Wish your favorite cast member well wishes by purchasing candy grams. Anyone can purchase candy-grams. They will be available to sell before each show in the school foyer.

**USB CAST PHOTOS AND ARCHIVED SHOW PERFORMANCE** – *NEW this year!* These are covered in your camp fees! There will be some specialty cast photos that will be available for purchase in the foyer should you want a photo book, or signed cast group photo in addition to your cast photo USB.
