

# Continuous Enrollment FAQ

## ***What is Continuous Enrollment, and how is it different from current reenrollment?***

Augustine Christian Academy is excited to announce the move to a Continuous Enrollment model. For our entire history, ACA has operated on an annual reenrollment model, in which parents complete a reenrollment packet every year. The overwhelming majority of parents decide to remain at ACA with around 95 percent of parents reenrolling. For many, taking the time to complete the reenrollment process has been a burden and sometimes, even, an oversight. We know that a committed, long-term educational partnership benefits our families and students. So, we want to stop adding time and tedium to our families.

As a result, ACA is moving to a Continuous Enrollment model. In this model, you will sign your child's one-time Continuous Enrollment agreement, and then be done! Your child will be continuously enrolled at ACA through high school graduation.

## ***What will happen this year?***

Beginning in February, you will be asked to complete one final reenrollment form showing that you understand that ACA has moved to the continuous enrollment model. You will complete the packet, just like you may have done in the past. You will agree to this Continuous Enrollment Agreement for 2026-2027 and all future years.

You will be invoiced for a reenrollment fee on the 1st of April, each year.

## ***What if I don't wish for my child to return for 2026-2027?***

## ***What happens in future years?***

There will be no reenrollment packets in future years. Your child will be considered continuously enrolled through high school graduation. An invoice will be sent for reenrollment in April of each year.

## ***What if I should need to withdraw my student for an upcoming future year?***

If the need arises for you to withdraw, you absolutely have that right. We would ask that you let the school know through email or in writing at the front office.

**Will I owe any money if I withdraw for the upcoming school year?**

No. If, in the future, you decide you need to find another school for your child, and you inform us of your need to withdraw, you will owe no tuition for the upcoming school year.

**Does a withdrawal process need to be completed if I don't wish my child to be enrolled for 2026-2027?**

If you do not wish to enroll your child for 2026-2027, simply do not complete the Continuous Enrollment Agreement in the online packet. Your child will be marked for withdrawal next year, and you will owe no tuition. A courtesy notification that you are changing schools would be appreciated, but not required.

If you complete the Continuous Enrollment Agreement, we will consider your child enrolled for 2026-2027. If you withdraw after signing the agreement, you must take the previously mentioned steps to withdraw your child.

**The Parental Choice Tax Credit (and tuition assistance decisions) will not be approved until March or April. What if I don't get a tax credit or financial aid, and it affects whether my family can afford to come?**

If a family is not approved for the PCTC or tuition assistance and this impacts your ability to afford a private education, please contact the Front Office as soon as you have determined if you need to withdraw.
