A non-refundable \$100 enrollment deposit per family is due when the student is enrolled and will be applied to tuition upon completion of enrollment. Friday tutoring sessions available for Part-Time students on a Per Diem basis.

#### **Financial Assistance Information:**

Multiple child discounts on students enrolled full-time:  $2^{nd}$  Child - 3% discount;  $3^{rd}$  child or more – 10% discount each.

#### Families with full-time students may apply for financial aid using FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment.

There is a limited amount of financial aid available each year. If you are a current recipient of tuition assistance, you must apply annually for consideration. Financial aid applications are submitted online at: online.factsmgt.com/aid. Financial aid flyer's are available in the school office. FACTS will make a recommendation as to need, but by board directive financial assistance may not exceed 50% (exceptions may apply in extreme circumstances).

#### **Tuition Payment Options:**

<u>Payment in full</u> – a 2% discount is available to those who pay the full year's tuition by June 30<sup>th</sup>. <u>Multiple payment options</u> from 2 to 12 payments— available *ONLY* through FACTS Tuition Management, a payment processing company that offers the options of bank drafts from savings & checking accounts. *ACA is not able to offer the option of monthly payments without using FACTS*. If you plan to pay your tuition using the FACTS payment options, a FACTS form must be completed and returned to the ACA office with this enrollment packet. Any changes to your FACTS payment plan must be transacted in writing in the school office. Payments are on the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month, whichever best fits your cash flow needs. Payments are to be completed by May of the school year.

## Tuition & Payment Information

#### INTRODUCTION

The school's Administration is responsible for setting the price of tuition, the manner of payment, and, in general, the development of policy in this area of concern. Their objective is to make the Christian classical education offered by Augustine Christian Academy as affordable and available as possible.

The Headmaster and Director of Operations believe that tuition payments are an investment in your child's education and preparation for life. We recognize that tuition payments often require financial sacrifice on the part of our families. We wish it were not so, but not everyone can afford private education.

The Headmaster and Director of Operations use tuition payment commitments for financial planning. It is also their responsibility to insure that timely payment is made in order to make adequate financial resources available for the school. To that end, these policy guidelines are established to clarify payment expectations.

#### APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT FEES

**New Families**: Families new to Augustine Christian Academy pay a one time non-refundable application fee of \$75. A non-refundable \$100 enrollment fee for each family will be required when the enrollment process is complete. This enrollment fee secures their position in class <u>and is applied toward tuition</u>.

**Returning families**: A non-refundable \$100 enrollment fee for each family will be required to complete the reenrollment process. The enrollment fee secures the student's position in class <u>and is applied toward tuition</u>. **Part-time students:** The enrollment contract must indicate the number of classes the student will take at ACA.

#### TUITION PAYMENT

**Pre-planning**: It is very important that you prayerfully and wisely consider your financial situation **before** you commit funds for your child's education to Augustine Christian Academy (ACA).

ACA makes financial commitments to vendors, teachers, staff, etc., in order to provide a quality education to its students. The monies received via tuition are used to help meet those financial obligations. The financial commitments made by ACA to others and the financial contract a family signs with ACA carry moral and legal obligations. Failure to comply with a payment obligation encumbers the school in a multitude of ways and is simply unfair to those who follow through on their commitments to ACA. Collection measures are in place for those who fail to meet their financial obligations.

**Full payment option**: Under this plan the entire amount of tuition is paid on or before the first day of school. A 2% discount shall be applied to the total tuition due if the payment is made by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Payment in the form of cash, check or money order must be postmarked or received in the school office by June 30<sup>th</sup> to receive the discount. No discount will be allowed for full payments after June 30<sup>th</sup>. If not paying in full, a **FACTS** Tuition Management Plan form *MUST* be completed before students will be allowed to attend classes.

**Installment payment option**: Under this plan the entire amount of tuition is paid in installments according to one of the payment schedules offered through the **FACTS** Tuition Management Plan. This plan is an automatic payment plan made through your checking or savings account or credit card. Those choosing this plan will authorize their financial institution to make automatic payments to **FACTS** on either the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. Payments are to be completed by May of the school year.

Even though you may plan to pay your tuition using one of the FACTS payment options, if the necessary paperwork is not in place to allow timely bank drafts to begin by June (12-month plan) or August (10-month plan), your student may not be permitted to attend class until such time as FACTS confirms an approved payment plan is in place. Communication is key.

Any changes to your **FACTS** payment plan must be transacted in writing in the school office. *No changes can be made over the phone.* 

#### LATE ENROLLMENTS

Families enrolling after June 30<sup>th</sup> may choose to fulfill their tuition obligation with either payment in full or by making installment payments via a **FACTS** payment plan.

Tuition for students enrolling after the first week of school shall be prorated according to an amount commensurate with the number of weeks remaining in the school year. Partial week attendance will be billed as starting on Monday of that week. Families enrolling late will not be eligible for the FACTS 12-month payment plan as all payments must be completed by May of the school year.


#### **DEFAULTED PAYMENTS**

School families who miss an installment payment due to insufficient funds will be assessed a missed payment fee by **FACTS** and may incur a fee from their own financial institution. The missed payment debit will be reattempted by **FACTS** in approximately two weeks and may result in a double payment as **FACTS** attempts the current month as well as the month in arrears. **Any tuition payment more than 61 days delinquent may result in dismissal of the student from school.** 

#### WITHDRAWAL/TUITION REFUNDS

The family of a student withdrawing prior to the first day of attendance will be refunded the entire tuition that has been paid less the \$75.00 application fee for new families and the \$100.00 enrollment fee. After the first day of attendance, if circumstances result in academic or financial based withdrawal, tuition refunds shall be prorated according to an amount commensurate with the number of weeks remaining in the school year.

# Augustine Christian Academy Statement of Faith

The approach to education adopted by ACA is based on Proverbs 9:10 "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding". We believe it is impossible to teach from a religiously neutral position. True knowledge and wisdom can only occur once a student recognizes and accepts the Truth of God's existence and sovereignty in the affairs of mankind. Because our educational model is based on the threshold notion that every student must start with a "fear of the Lord" and a "knowledge of the Holy One", recognition and acceptance of ACA's Statement of Faith is central to a student's successful enrollment. It is the backbone of our ACA body. Our Statement of Faith is modeled after the basic tenets of Apostles' Creed and is tied to the historic profession of Faith shared by all Christians at all times universally. In particular, we believe the following[1]:

- We believe that all life is created and sustained by God (Isa 42:5) and can only be properly understood in terms of God's purpose throughout history, to bring glory to His name and to develop His kingdom.
- We believe that the Word of God, both the Old and New Testaments, is the only true and final authority for the believer. (2 Pet 1:20-21) The Scriptures, being self-validating, properly direct us in our relationship to God and our relationship to other men and the rest of creation.
- We believe that God is a Spirit, eternally existing in three persons, and is the Creator and Sustainer of the universe. He is the Author of all truth. All theories of man, while recognized as legitimate for study, must be validated in terms of God and the absolutes of His revealed Word. (Psalm 36:9)
- We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, (Mark 1:1) the second person of the Trinity, (Mt 28:19) very God, and very man, equal in power and glory with God the Father.
- We believe Christ's resurrection established Him as victor over death, affirmed His kingship and guaranteed His ultimate victory over the kingdom of Satan. (Rom 1:4) As our King He rules over us and defends us, putting all enemies under His feet.
- We believe that the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, (Mt 28:19) and proceeds in His work from the Father and the Son. He is that Person of the Godhead who illuminates the mind and the heart of the believer; leading them in the truth while working obedience in their life, assisting and comforting them in the distresses of the world, and convicting the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment. (John 16:13)
- We believe that man was made in the image of God. (Gen 1:27) In this exalted position He rules the world under God. All mankind sinned in Adam, and is subject to the wrath and curse of God. Man stands in need of regeneration, the impartation of life by a sovereign and gracious act of God, and the forgiveness of man's sins through faith in the vicarious atonement of Christ. (Romans 5: 12-15)
- We believe in the historic definition of Marriage recognizing that marriage is the foundational unit of society, and that the Bible and the historic Church define marriage as the permanent, exclusive, comprehensive, and conjugal "one flesh" union of one man and one woman, intrinsically ordered to procreation and biological family, and in furtherance of the moral, spiritual, and public good of binding father, mother, and child. We also believe that any sexual activity outside this historical definition of marriage is incompatible with Scripture and historic Christian teaching and practice.
